



Reminder of Key points for children attending school week beginning Monday 22nd June

Dear Parents/Carer,

I would like to ask all parents to check details for their children if they are returning to school on Monday. These can be found in our published plan. Please click on the link:

Below are some key points to act as a **reminder** for more children returning to school on Monday 22nd June 2020.

- **Start times and finish times:** We are staggering start and finish times, please refer to the plan using the link below and check this information for child's class. It is important to note that some children are entering and leaving school at different points. Please click on the link and refer to section 3 pages 6-10 to check this.

- **Social distance queuing:** On entering and leaving school, children and parents will have to queue at the relevant entrance point in a marked area. A member of staff will be there upon arrival on Monday to guide children coming into school.
- **Lunch:** children need to bring in a packed lunch.
- **Equipment:** No equipment, work books, book bags, home school work or other bags should be brought into school with the children. Only a small lunch bag, water bottle and coat if required are need to be brought in.
- **Not congregating:** Parents are also reminded we are asking them not to congregate and hold conversations on school premises. Once you have dropped your child off or collected them we ask that you please leave the school site via the one way systems which will be in place.
- **Year 6:** any Year 6 children walking on their own should ensure they DO NOT arrive early and are fully aware of the social distancing for lining up. Please email the office at bursar@aughtonchristchurch.lancs.sch.uk if your child is walking either to or from school to confirm this.

We are very much looking forward to seeing these groups of children returning to school. We now have over 100 children returning to school.
